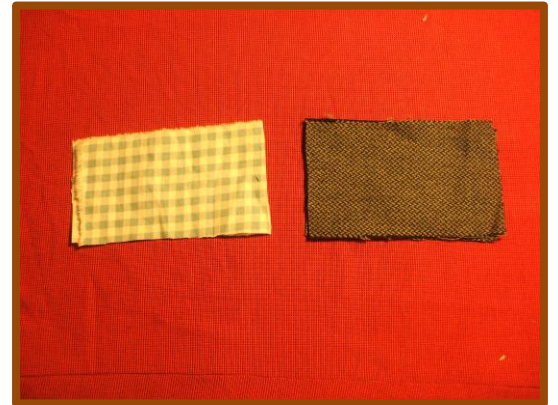


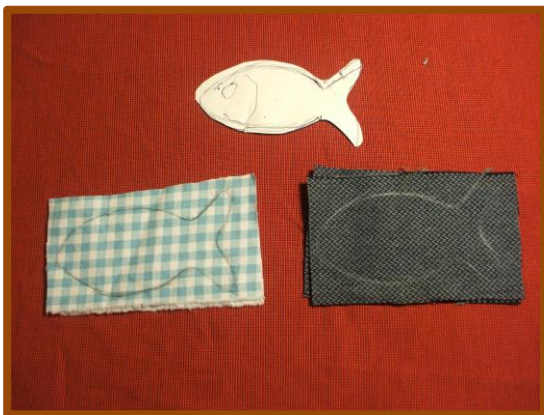
Fabric Fish with Tan Draig: for the 'Derwent Delights' project

STEP 1

Take two pieces of fabric. The ones I used were 7cm x 4.5 cm



STEP 2



Draw the outline of a fish on them.
If you are going to make more than one, you may want to make a card template

STEP 3

On another small piece of fabric, write a word that comes to mind when you think of the Derwent Valley.



STEP 4



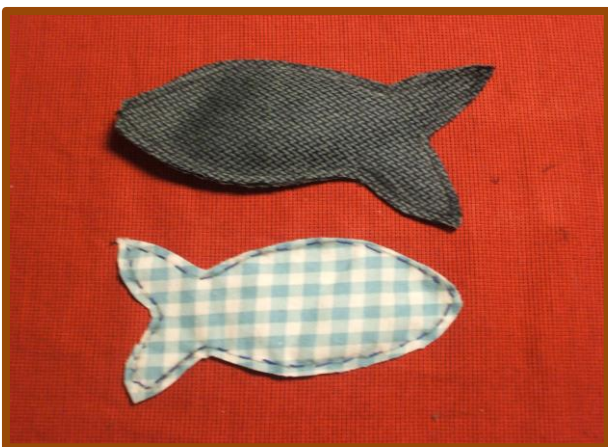
Place this word and a small amount of stuffing inside the fish, making sure it all fits inside the fish outline.

STEP 5

Pin them together then hand or machine stitch around the outline.



STEP 7



Cut out the fish.

STEP 8



Decorate the fish with embroidery. I used herringbone (a good one for fish) Fern stitch, feather stitch and French knots.

STEP 9

Add a button or sequin for an eye.
Now you have made one, a challenge would be to see how small you can make the next one!
